After graduating Sandusky High School, Ben Espy earned a BA from the Ohio State University, and his Juris Doctorate from Howard University Law School. He served his country as a Captain in the United States Air Force and served our state as Chief of the Ohio Attorney General's Criminal Activities Division and Deputy Chief of Civil Rights Division.

Ben Espy has 38 years of experience as a practicing attorney, including appearances before the Ohio Supreme Court. In 1996, Senator Espy became Senate Minority Leader, a position he held until 2000. He was the first African-American Ohioan to be the top leader of one of the General Assembly's four legislative caucuses.
