

Who is able to access this resource?

Any Sinclair student who is planning to take the TEAS test for the first time, or preparing to retake the test.

What is provided?

The TEAS prep and remediation curriculum is administered via software licensed through the Academic Resource Center (ARC) at Sinclair—at NO COST to students. The web-based curriculum is aligned to TEAS exam objectives and focuses on the four TEAS subject areas—English, Reading, Science and Math.

How does it work?

The curriculum is provided via eLearn, so once the student is enrolled it can be accessed any location where the Internet is available.

What topics are covered?

The curriculum begins with a pretest in each of the subject unit topics. Students are provided a pretest score and feedback regarding the topics that require further instruction or remediation.
