

ANGEL Learning System

As a student registered for a course at Sinclair, you are given a user name and password that allows you to become part of the ANGEL Learning System. As of Fall 2006, Sinclair began using this system for all on-line courses, course enhancements, and to power the my.Sinclair portal.

ANGEL is a web-based course management and collaboration portal that enables faculty to manage course materials and to communicate quickly, easily, and effectively with students. ANGEL can function both as a complement to traditional in-class courses and as a site for distance learning.

What will you find on ANGEL in Nursing? Each course and each section within the course will have an ANGEL site. Faculty will post documents online, such as portions of your LRP, calendars; administer practice quizzes; administer surveys; send and receive course mail; establish and monitor message boards and chat rooms; receive and grade uploaded assignment and journals; use online drop boxes; create teams for discussion or for special topics; and more. Nursing faculty will orient you to what is found and expected with ANGEL in your course each quarter.

STUDENT LOGON PROCEDURE

1. Go to my.Sinclair (<http://my.sinclair.edu>)
2. Enter your username (usually your first name.last name)
3. Enter your password

When you log into ANGEL, you are presented with your personal page – Home. Some provide you with access to all courses you are taking.
