

Directions to Sinclair

From Northbound or Southbound I-75 in downtown Dayton:

- Take the Third Street Exit (53A)
- Turn East onto Third Street
- Turn right onto Perry Street (approximately 1/4 mile off I-75)
- Turn right on Fourth Street (2 blocks)
- Turn left under the second walk way
- Turn right immediately into Lot A on Fifth Street

From Eastbound SR-35 in downtown Dayton:

- Take I-75 North to the Third Street Exit (53A)
- Turn East onto Third Street
- Turn right onto Perry Street (approximately 1/4 mile off I-75)
- Turn right on Fourth Street (2 blocks)
- Turn left under the second walk way
- Turn right immediately into Lot A on Fifth Street

From Westbound SR-35 in downtown Dayton:

- Take the Main Street/Jefferson Street Exit
- Turn right onto Jefferson Street
- Turn left onto Fourth Street (west)
- Continue on Fourth Street past Perry Street (5 blocks)
- Turn left under the second walk way
- Turn right immediately into Lot A on Fifth Street

From Northbound SR-48 (Main Street) in downtown Dayton:

- Turn left onto Monument Avenue
- Turn left onto Perry Street
- Turn right on Fourth Street (5 blocks)
- Turn left under the second walk way
- Turn right immediately into Lot A on Fifth Street

From Southbound SR-48 (Main Street) in downtown Dayton:

- Turn right onto Monument Avenue
- Turn left onto Perry Street
- Turn right on Fourth Street (5 blocks)
- Turn left under the second walk way
- Turn right immediately into Lot A on Fifth Street

Walking Directions from the Double Tree Hotel:

- Turn left when exiting the hotel.
- Turn left on Third Street.
- Walk two blocks to Perry Street (Building 12, Sinclair David H. Ponitz Center).
- Enter through the first floor of Building 12.
- Take the south elevator (to the left) to the third floor and follow the signs to Building 3.
- Take elevator down to basement to Room 3001

Driving Directions from the Double Tree Hotel:

- Turn right when exiting the parking garage
- Turn right on Fourth Street (1 block)
- Turn left under the second walk way
- Turn right immediately into Lot A on Fifth Street
