

ACI APPLICATION ELIGIBILITY AND REQUIREMENTS UNDERGRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM 2009-10

Applications Must Be Received No Later Than Friday, January 15, 2010

A. Eligibility:

1. Applicant must have completed one full year of course work in a 2, 4 or 5 year program.
2. Applicant must be registered as a full time student.
3. Applicant must desire a career in construction.
4. Applicant must pursue a degree in a construction related program, such as construction management, civil engineering, architectural engineering technology or related programs. (A dual degree with construction or construction/civil engineering as one part is acceptable.)
5. Applicant must be a U.S. citizen.

B. Requirements:

1. Applicant is responsible for ensuring that all of the following items are submitted as one package and received no later than January 15, 2010.
 - a. A fully completed and typed application form. (Handwritten applications will not be accepted.)
 - b. Three Letters of Recommendation (At least two if not all three of the following types must be received: Personal, Professional, Academic).
 - c. Resume must be attached to Application with chronological employment history briefly describing duties and responsibilities.
 - d. Submit a 150 word bio that details why you are going into the construction industry, do you have family members currently or previously in the industry, your community involvement and any special awards that you may have received.
 - e. Official College Transcripts only. (Grade Reports will not be accepted). Note: Official College Transcripts may be submitted separate of fully completed application.
2. Recipient(s) must be able to attend ACI's Annual Meeting held on March 18, 2010.

C. Awards:

1. Various scholarships will be awarded ranging in several categories from \$1,000 to \$5,000 per recipient.
2. Applications will be reviewed and recipients selected by the ACI Scholarship Committee, which will consider the applicant's interest in construction, grades, extracurricular activities, employment experience, letters of recommendation and financial status.
3. All applicants selected as semi-finalists will be subject to a personal interview with a representative or representatives of the ACI Scholarship Committee. Semi-finalists will be notified no Later than February 13, 2010.
4. Award(s) will be presented at the ACI Annual Meeting, held on March 18, 2010. Recipients will be notified. Again, **the recipient's presence at this meeting is mandatory.**
5. Checks will be given directly to the recipient(s) and made payable to both the recipient and college or university to ensure the money is used for tuition and/or books. Checks will not be sent to the recipient's college or university.

Applicants must ensure that their application, letters of recommendation and Official transcripts are received by the January 15, 2010 deadline.
