

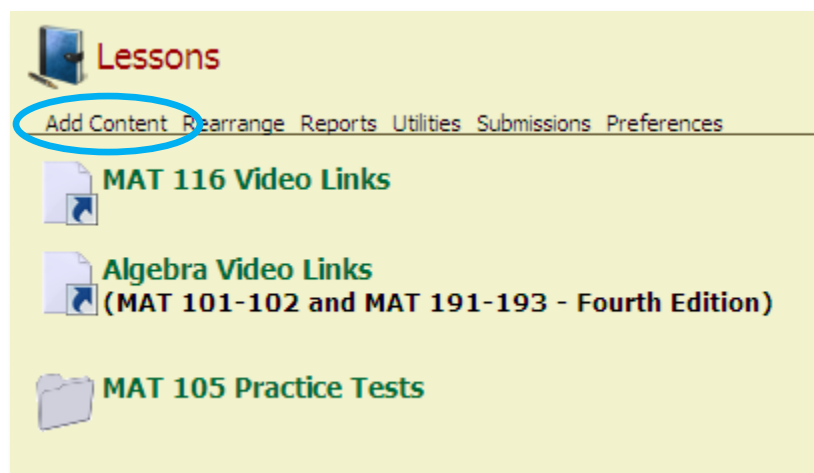
Adding Math Lab Content to Your ANGEL Course

As time permits, we are continually creating new (and updating current) content for inclusion into your ANGEL course shell. We desire to utilize this resource as much as possible to help you enrich your course for your students. This document will show you how to import our content into your course shell. I'll be using a demo shell for this demonstration.

1. First, go to your course home page and click on "Lessons" at the top.






2. Then, click on "Add Content" (your Lessons page may look different than mine).





3. Next, click on "Import from Learning Object Repository".

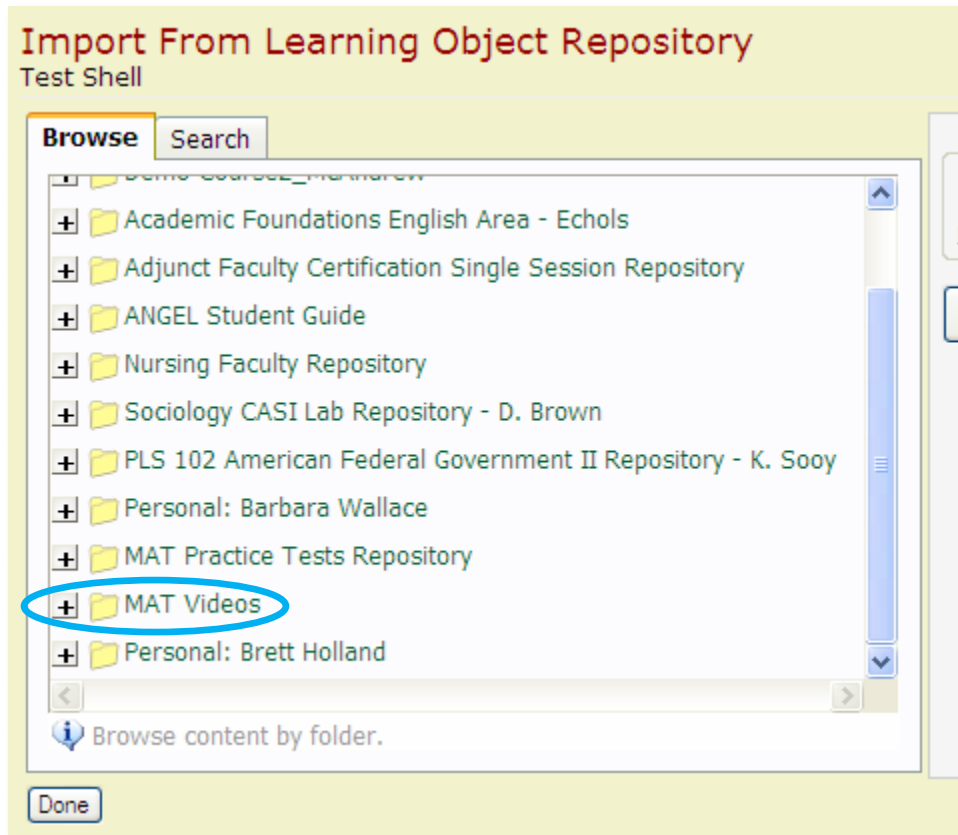
More Options

-  **Copy Items**
Create a duplicate of an existing folder or item.
-  **Import from Learning Object Repository**
Copy or link to items in the Learning Object Repository
-  **Import from a Course or Group**
Copy items from any other course or group in which you are an editor

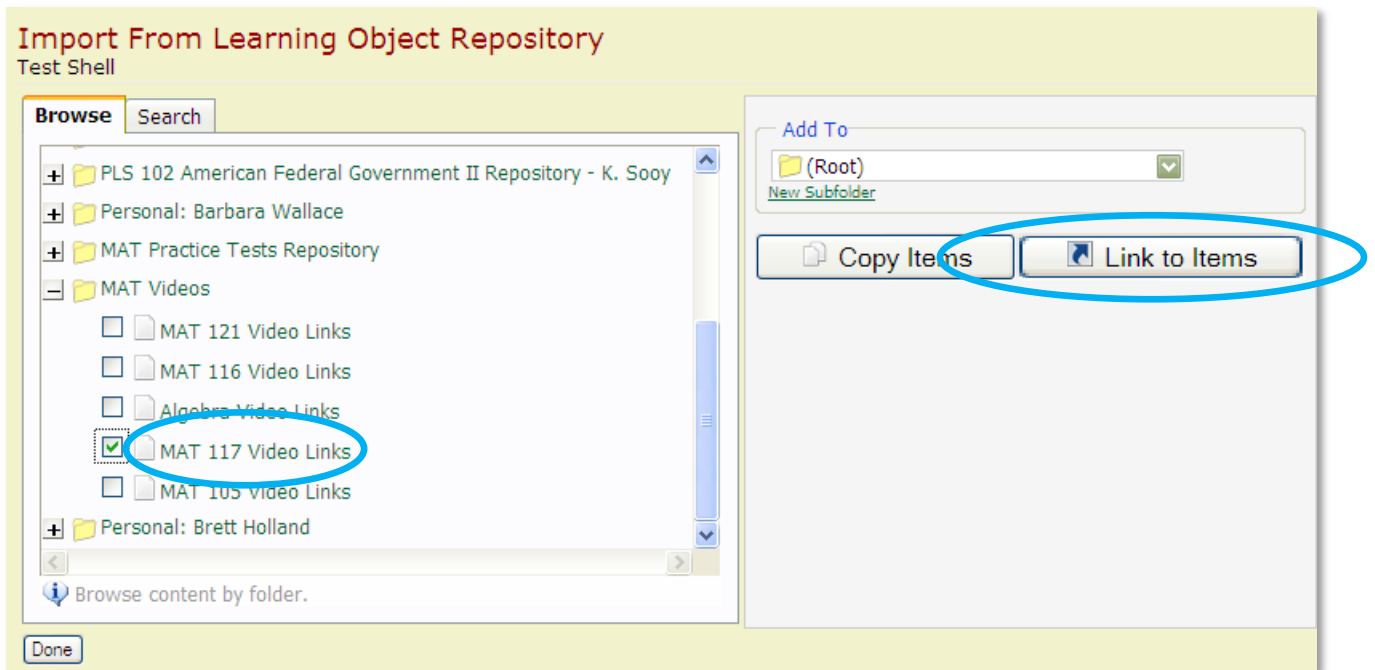
Templates and Wizards

-  **Add content from MERLOT**
Add content from MERLOT
-  **Add From Template**
Add content using a predefined template.

- Let's add the Trigonometry video links to my demo shell. Look through the list and find the "MAT Videos" repository. Click the "+" button beside it to display the contents inside.



5. Select the “MAT 117 Video Links” page by placing a check mark in the box, and click the “Link to Items” button. Do not copy! If you copy the page instead of linking to it, any updates we make will not be reflected in your course shell.



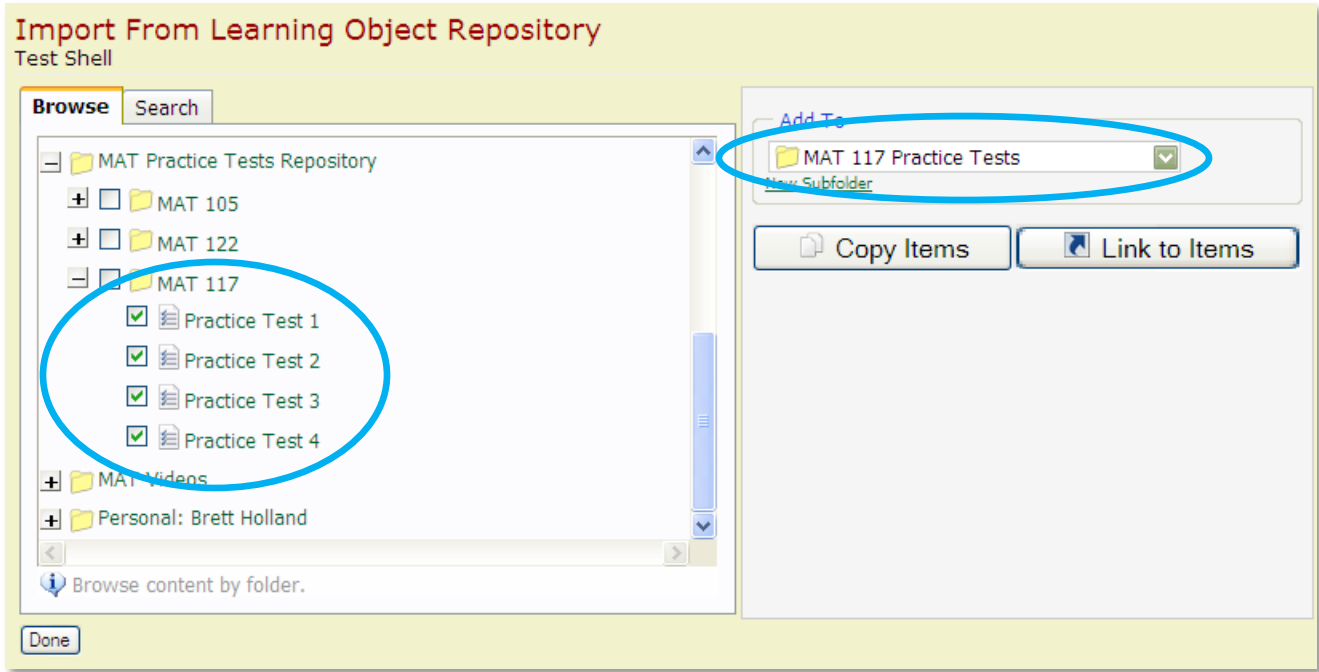
6. After the items are imported successfully, this message will appear. Click “Ok” and then “Done” to return to your Lessons page.



7. Let's now import the MAT 117 practice tests into my demo shell. Notice that I have already added a folder to hold the new links.



- Go back into “Import from Learning Object Repository”, but this time, look for “MAT Practice Tests Repository” and click the “+” beside it. Then click the “+” button beside “MAT 117”. Place a check mark beside all four practice tests. Before clicking the “Link to Items” button, make sure that the “MAT 117 Practice Tests” folder is selected in the “Add To” drop-down menu.



- Click “Ok” and then “Done”.



And there we go! The Trigonometry video links and practice tests are now on my “Lessons” page. Check back often for new and updated content as we plan to add more material in the months ahead.
