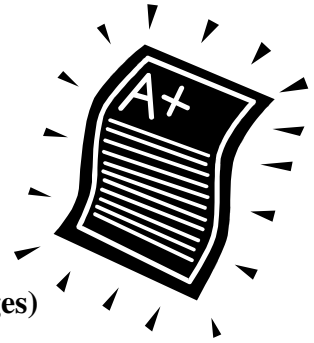

Student Mathematics League
2012 Winter Quarter Competition

What is it? A one-hour, 20 question, multiple-choice exam. The level of the exam is precalculus mathematics. Topics from algebra, trigonometry, analytic geometry and probability may be included. A scientific or graphing calculator is permitted; however, the TI-92, any other calculator with a keyboard, or a computer is not permitted.

This is the first (Round I) of two exams, the second exam being held in the Winter Quarter. Each exam covers precalculus mathematics.

Who can participate?

Any student enrolled at Sinclair Community College who has not yet earned a two-year degree or higher. As a minimum prerequisite, it is recommended that students have completed MAT 116, College Algebra, or its equivalent, or are currently taking MAT 116; however, students of all levels of mathematics are invited to participate.

When? 10:00 – 11:00 a.m., Saturday, February 18, 2012

Where? Room 3-001

Why take it? ☺ Compete for **\$3000 national scholarship**. At the end of the second test in the winter, the scores from each test will be totaled. The student with the highest score wins. The national award is a \$3000 scholarship (only two-year college students are eligible for this award), as well as runner-up prizes. In addition to the individual competition, there is a team competition. The top five scores for each exam are added together to get a team score.

☺ Compete for **local prizes**. For each exam the student with the highest score wins a prize of **\$50**. There are also second and third-place prizes of **\$30** and **\$20**. Also, the student who has the highest cumulative score on both exams (Rounds I & II – must take both rounds) will earn a **\$50** prize, and the runner-up will receive a **\$25** prize. In the case of ties, prizes will be split.
