Sinclair Workforce Development to Host Training Information Sessions

Dayton, Ohio – Workforce Development at Sinclair Community College is sponsoring two free information sessions about training currently available in rapidly expanding manufacturing career fields. The sessions will provide individuals with details on the **Precision Machining** and **SkillsTrac Industrial Maintenance Technician** training programs. Dislocated workers are encouraged to attend as they may be eligible for training funds.

Introduction to Precision Machining and **CNC Precision Machining** are two courses that are being offered to prepare workers for a career as an entry level machinist. This series is well suited for individuals who have some basic manufacturing experience and would like to learn how to operate and program CNC – computer numerical controls - equipment.

SkillsTrac is a comprehensive industrial maintenance technician training program specially designed for the advanced manufacturing industry. It is a multi-level training program designed to grow highly needed skills at each level. Students earn a certificate for each level successfully completed. Typical salaries in the industrial maintenance field range from \$14 to \$20 per hour.

The information sessions will be at 5-7 p.m. on Tuesday, December 14, and 1-3 p.m. on Wednesday, December 15. The sessions will be held in the Tartan Terrace Room, fourth floor of Building 13, on Sinclair's downtown Dayton campus.
