

HOW TO CALCULATE YOUR GRADE POINT AVERAGE (GPA)

To determine your GPA, use the following scale:

- A = 4 points
- B = 3 points
- C = 2 points
- D = 1 point
- F = 0 points

NOTE: course that you earned a X, I, W, P, N, S, IP, U, or Y are not figured into your GPA



$$\text{GRADE POINTS} \div \text{CREDIT HOURS} = \text{GPA}$$

- 1** Multiply the # of credits each class is worth by the point value for the letter grade you earned
- 2** Total the grade points of all your classes
- 3** Divide that total by the # of credit hours you attempted

EXAMPLE:

Class	Grade	Credits	Grade Points
ENG 111	B (3 points)	3	9
PSY 119	C (2 points)	5	10
BIO 141	D (1 point)	4	4
ALH 103	A (4 points)	3	12
	Total	15	35

$$35 \div 15 = 2.33 \text{ GPA}$$



Your cumulative GPA is calculated the same way except that you have to calculate every quarter!
