

Online FAFSA Workshops

The Financial Aid & Scholarships office is now offering online FAFSA workshops. Students **must** submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to the U.S. Department of Education in order to be considered for financial aid and some scholarships.

The workshops are administered by the Financial Aid & Scholarships staff. Information is presented on how to apply for financial aid and what types of financial aid are available. Computers are available for students to use to submit their FAFSA applications online with assistance from the staff members.

No reservation is needed; however, space is limited. Therefore, please do not bring children. If you arrive and the session is full, you will need to come back to another scheduled session.

In order to complete the 2011-2012 FAFSA process for winter 2012, spring 2012 and summer 2012, students **must** bring:

- Student's 2010 Federal Income Tax Return
- Parent's 2010 Federal Income Tax Return (dependent students only)
- Student's 2010 W2s
- Parent's 2010 W2s (dependent students only)
- Parent's social security number, birth date, marital status and date (dependent students only, documentation is not required)
- Amounts of any additional income received in the entire year of 2010 such as child support, social security, welfare benefits, etc. (documentation is not required)
- Eligible non-citizens - please bring your permanent resident card
- Ink pen and paper

In order to complete the 2012-2012 FAFSA process for fall 2012, spring 2013 and summer 2013, students must bring tax and income information for 2011 and other documentation as listed above.

If students do not have a copy of the federal tax forms or W-2s, they can request a Tax Transcript or Wage Transcript from the IRS by calling 1-800-829-1040 or by visiting their Web site at www.irs.gov.

If students do not have the appropriate documents, they are still welcome to come to the workshop. They will receive valuable information, have the opportunity to ask questions and learn how to navigate through the FAFSA Web site.
