My Guide to Planning and Success

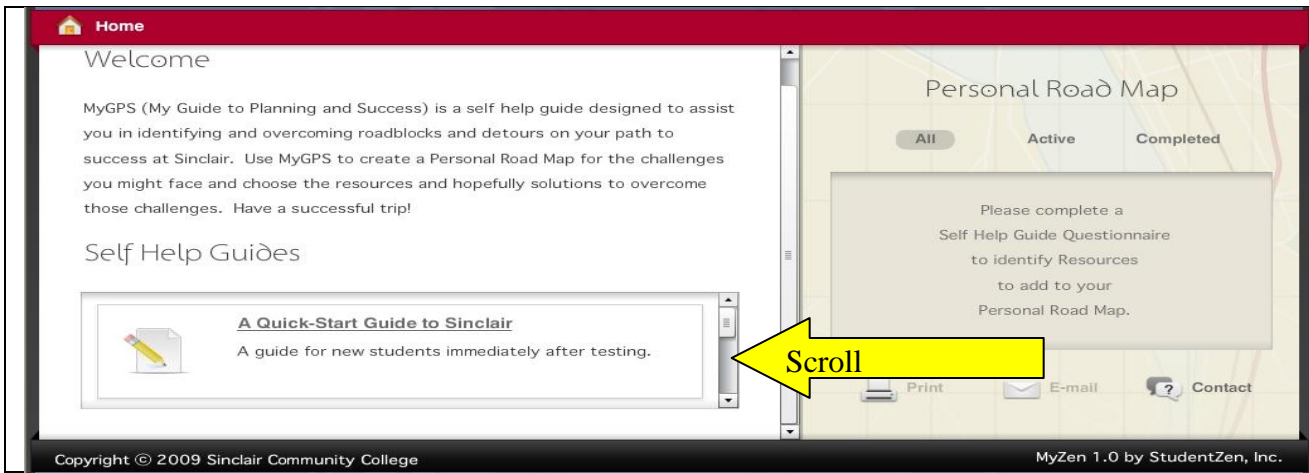

Enter your Sinclair username and password.

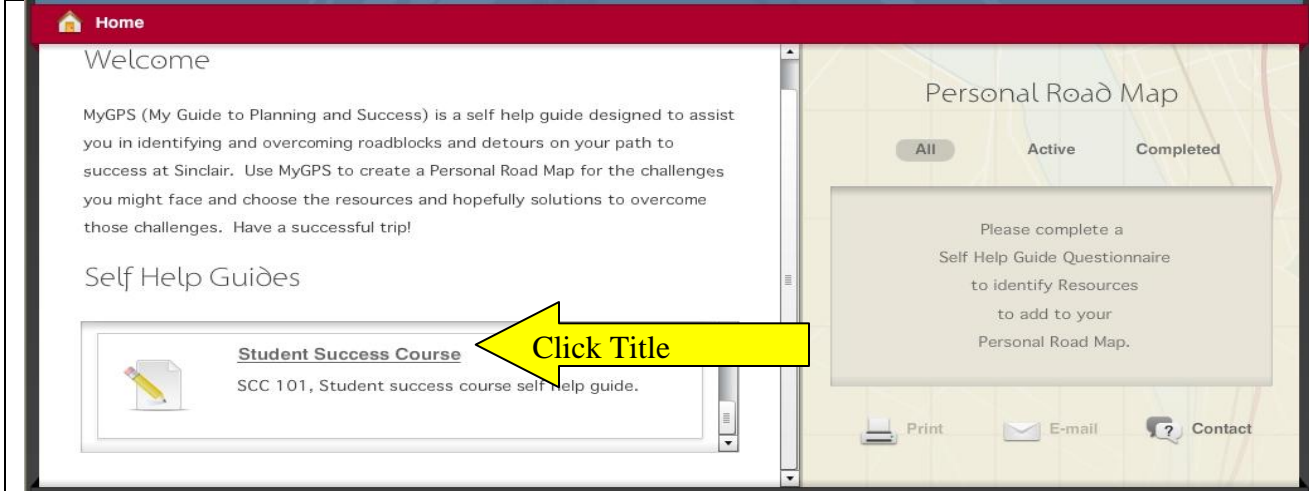

Layout of System

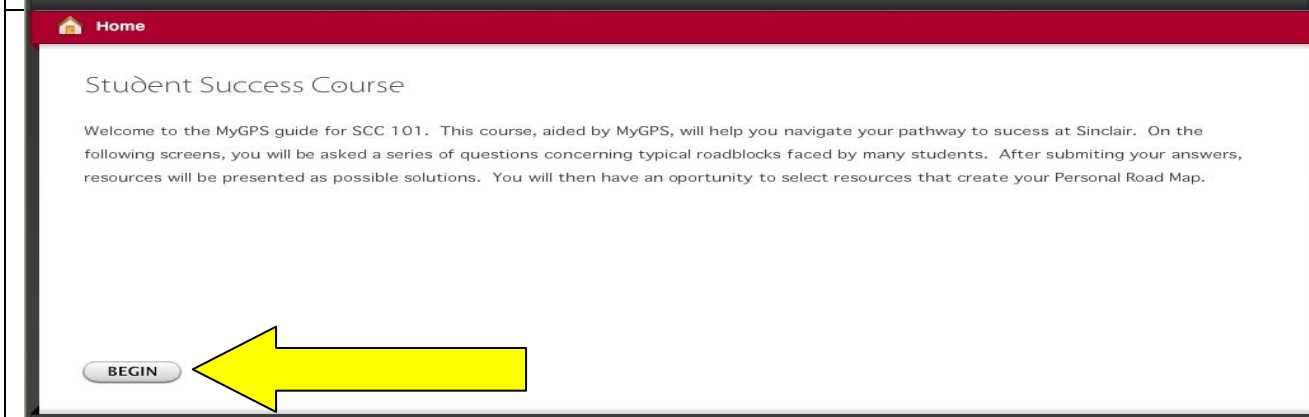
On the left side of the screen, several different guides on different subjects are listed. To see all guides, scroll through the list.
