Application Instructions

Application Period: February 1 – April 1, 2026 (rolling admissions until capacity is reached).

Application can be accessed via a portal link on the Sinclair EFDA webpage or here https://sinclaircc.wufoo.com/forms/dental-auxiliaries-shortterm-certificate/.

Interested individuals can email <u>EFDA@sinclair.edu</u> to receive an email with a link to the application once it becomes available.

All application materials must be uploaded directly to the application portal. **Documents sent via email** will not be accepted.

Applications will not be reviewed until all required items are submitted.

Required Documentation:

- Completed application with your signature and the required DDS signatures.

- Copy of current Certified/Registered Dental Assistant (CDA or RDA) or Registered Dental Hygienist (RDH) credentials showing expiration date
- Copy of current BLS Healthcare Provider CPR certification
- Proof of Hepatitis B immunity or vaccination

Program Overview

The **Expanded Function Dental Auxiliary (EFDA) Certificate Program** is a sequential, three-semester program totaling **13 credit hours (180 contact hours)**. Students receive intensive education and training in the placement of amalgam and tooth-colored restorations.

Eligibility:

Applicants must have a minimum of 2 years of clinical assisting experience.

Applicants must be one of the following:

- Certified Dental Assistant (CDA)
- Registered Dental Assistant (RDA)
- Registered Dental Hygienist (RDH)

Prerequisite: CDAs and RDAs must first complete **Dental Anatomy (EFD 1102)**, a six-week summer Aterm course, before advancing to EFDA courses in the fall and spring.

Certification: Upon completion of the program, graduates are eligible to sit for the state-designated Ohio EFDA examination. Passing this exam is required for EFDA registration with the Ohio State Dental Board.

Class Schedule

Students indicate a preferred class day (Monday, Wednesday, or Friday, 8:30 AM – 3:30 PM). While preferences are considered, final assignments depend on lab availability. If enrollment does not support three sections, only two will be offered.

Orientation

A mandatory orientation will be held on the first Wednesday in April (prior to the summer term). Students will register for courses at this time.

- New students: Apply to Sinclair at https://apply.sinclair.edu/.
- Returning students: Update your Sinclair account if it has not been active within the past year.

Failure to complete these steps will delay program entry.

Program Expectations

- EFDA students must be familiar with restorative dental procedures before beginning EFD 1102.
- The program is **time-intensive and demanding**, requiring consistent attendance, textbook/lecture study, weekly assignments, quizzes, midterms, and finals.
- Courses must be completed in sequence to progress.
- Students must demonstrate fine motor skills, attention to detail, and the ability to work with both direct and indirect vision.

Clinical Experience

- Students must secure a **satellite dental office** and supervising dentist for their clinical practice. Sinclair does not provide placements.
- Clinical participation begins once lab proficiency is demonstrated and approved by the course coordinator.
- Satellite Dentist Night (mandatory): First Wednesday in December, 7:00–8:00 PM. Both students and supervising dentists must attend. Absence may prevent program continuation.

Program Costs

- EFD 1102 Dental Anatomy (Summer): 1 credit hour
- Fall & Spring EFDA Courses: 12 credit hours (6 each semester)
- Total Program Hours: 13 credit hours

Estimated Costs (Montgomery County residents):

- Tuition: Based on current Sinclair tuition rates
- Lab Kit (Fall): \$2,000
- Lab Kit (Spring): \$1,000
- Lab Fees: \$180 (Fall) + \$180 (Spring)
- Books: ~\$100
- Total Estimated Program Cost: \$6,185

Important:

- Fees are due at the beginning of each semester; no exceptions.
- As a short-term certificate program, EFDA is not typically eligible for financial aid. Students
 pursuing an associate degree in health sciences may qualify for aid depending on total credit
 hours. Contact an Academic Advisor at 937-512-3700 for guidance.

State Registration

To become a registered EFDA with the Ohio State Dental Board, graduates must pass one of the following exams (approx. \$850, subject to change):

- Commission on Dental Testing: <u>CODT State Board Exam</u>
- American Board of Dental Examiners EFDA Exam: ADEX Board Exam

Exams are offered in May following program completion. Testing with Sinclair-provided equipment is available at the Dayton Campus.

Note: Successful program completion does not guarantee passing the exam.
